# **Camp Blanding 600 yard Rifle Match w/pits and a MFRF pop-up match**

**April 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> / 2011**

**Matches are non-sanctioned but NRA rules will be used with some exceptions**

**Only .308/30-06/.223 calibers are allowed for rifles!!!!!!!**

600 yard match classes will include:

- F-Class (T/R and Open as one) with  
Tactical Rifle, Any other Rifle and Long Range Pistol

- NRA Match Rifle – NRA Service Rifle

there will also be a

**MRFR (modified record fire range)**

**Military Rifle and Pistol Pop-Up match**

Course of Fire:

Friday – April 8<sup>th</sup> – 3 x 20 shots w/sighters @ 600 yards

Saturday – April 9<sup>th</sup> - 3 x 20 shots w/sighters @ 600 yards

Sunday - April 10<sup>th</sup> - MFRF Pop-up match

pop-up targets will be single or multiple targets for rifle with ranges from 50 to 300 meters and pistol targets from 25 to 75 meters

**Match Fees:**

for 600 yard matches: \$30.00 per day if pre-registered

for MFRF : \$60.00 if pre-registered

Pre-registration is recommended, a fee of \$10 per day will be added for

On site registration.

Squadding for the 600yard matches will be from 7:45am to 8:15am

(gate will open at 7:30 and be locked at 8:15)

Safety briefing at 8:30am (required), pits seal at 8:45am and

Shooting to begin at 9:00am

Squadding and safety briefing for Pop- Up match will begin at 8:00am

Shooting to begin at 0:830 am

**NCSA membership is required for insurance purposes.**

## General Rules for All Matches

**Rifles / Pistols must stay cased until on the firing line and not opened until prep period begins.**

**Rifles / Pistols must be cased or holstered as soon as shooter finishes.**

**No one may handle any rifle or pistol behind the firing line.**

**Camp Blanding minimum age requirement 18 years as of the Day of match.**

**Compensators and Muzzle Brakes:** None allowed – NRA rule 3.16.1

**Ammunition:** Any safe ammunition. Supplied by the competitor – NRA Rule 3.17.

**Bolt Closing:** All competitors shall close the bolt *only* when the rifle is parallel to the ground and pointed at the targets or the berm. the finger shall not be inside the trigger guard until the rifle is horizontal and pointed at the correct target.

**Brass and Trash Call:** There will be a brass and trash call after each relay change. All brass and trash are to be picked up by the competitor before he clears the line.

**EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS** will be required at all matches – NRA Rule 3.21. In addition, if the rifle is equipped with a removable magazine, that magazine must be removed when the ECI is inserted.

**Eye Protection and Ear Protection:**  
Eye and ear protection is REQUIRED

**Ready Line:** A ready line will be established and indicated on the range. Only the competitor scoring for an active shooter may be in front of the ready line. All conversations are to take place BEHIND this line. Please be courteous to those still shooting.

**Miscellaneous:** Food is not available at the range - competitors should bring fluids, snacks and lunch with them. No trash is to be placed in the toilets.

**Smoking:**

Smoking will be allowed in designated areas only. **No** smoking on the Firing line. Smoking behind the ready line and in the pits is permitted.

**All cigarette butts must be field stripped and removed from the range.**

**Parking:** Allowed behind the Range, in designated areas only. No parking in the pit area.

**Targets:** 600 yards - MR-1 target. F-Class / Any other / Tactical / Pistol will shoot on the MR-1 FC target.

**Arms:** Any safe rifle, .30 caliber or less, metallic or scope sights – NRA Rule 3.1., 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 3.3.1, 3.3.2

Exceptions:

Tactical rifles may use their bipods.

F-classes will be combined together with Any other rifle, Tactical and Pistol

**Weather:** Matches will be fired regardless of mildly inclement weather. Severe weather may cause the Match Director to delay relays until the situation improves.

**Sportsmanship:** Rule 9.27 will be administered by the Match Director. Those not adhering to the rule will be asked to leave the range. No refunds will be given for any remaining matches.

**Course of fire:****Friday :**

- **Match 1:** 600 yards, unlimited sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, total time 30 minutes.
- **Match 2:** 600 yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, total time 22 minutes.
- **Match 3:** 600 yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, total time 22 minutes.

## Saturday:

- **Match 4:** 600 yards, unlimited sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, total time 30 minutes.
- **Match 5:** 600 yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, total time 22 minutes.
- **Match 6:** 600 yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, total time 22 minutes.

## Firing Order:

Because of the way the relays are run the competitors will only be able to shoot in one class per day unless they provide a person to handle their pit pulling / scoring duties for the extra relay they will be shooting.

If the competitor wants to shoot different classes, one on each day, then they will not need to get a pit/scoring person. But that will eliminate the competitor from being able to win an aggregate award.

### Awards:

Awards will be given for First, Second and Third place each day in each class. Plus Aggregate Awards will be given for First place for combined score totals from both days. Information not covered in this program will be covered at the range at the time of the match. If any additional information is needed contact NCSA, LTD
